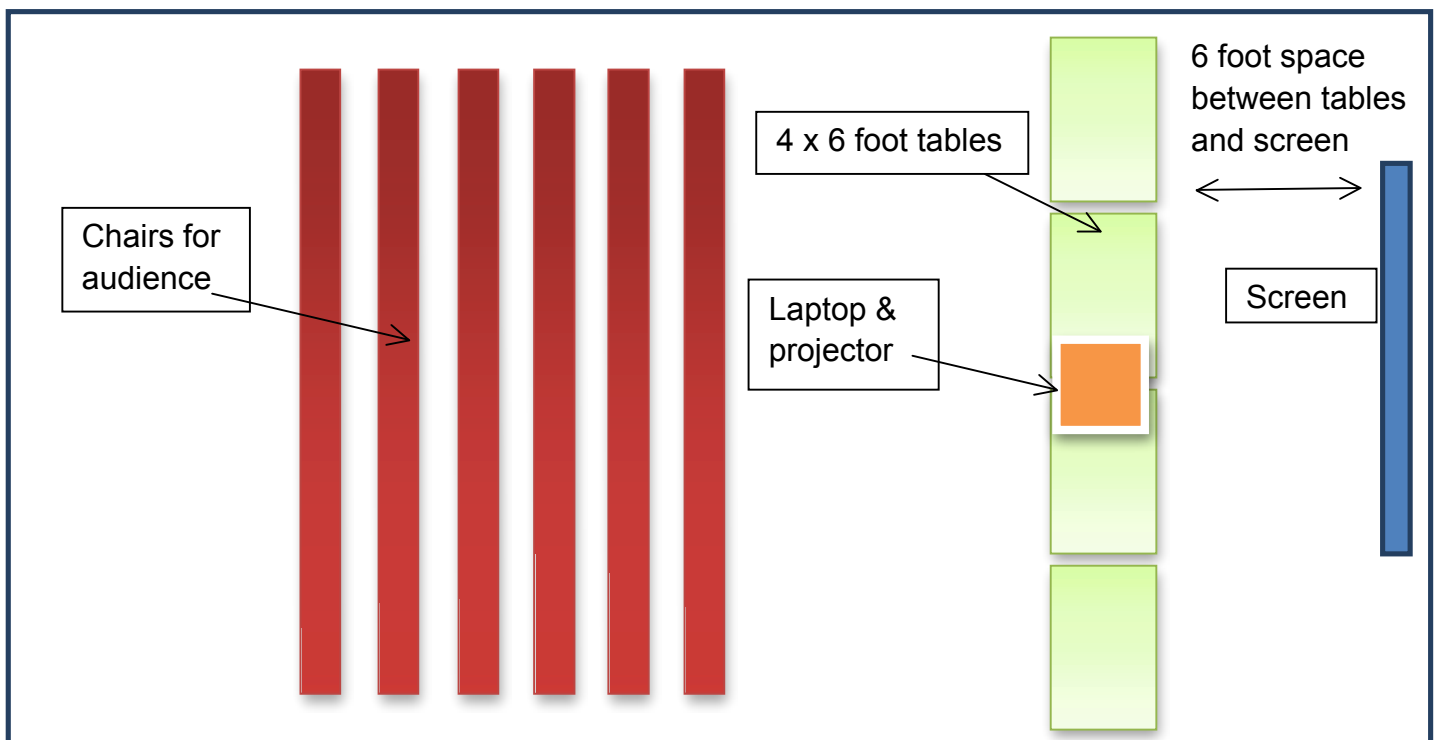

Show requirements

The show requires a room at least 14 feet wide to put all the models out. A plug socket will need to be within 6 feet of where the tables will go to run the models and the laptop/projector/speakers. See below for a standard room layout and a picture giving an idea how the show looks. We ideally need 24 feet of space for the tables, but at a pinch, we can get by with an 18ft minimum.

The show takes an hour to set up and another hour to put away. Please ensure that there is a parking space as near as possible to the venue to facilitate a speedy entrance and exit. If there are **ANY** issues around getting to the venue, then please let us know as it will then take longer to set up and pack away.
